
ABOUT MADCUP

Founded in 2019, MADCUP is a multinational project that promotes sport as a driver of social, educational, cultural, economic and health-related transformation. Its core focus is grassroots sport, with football as its main axis, and an expansion that includes basketball – both elite and grassroots – as well as volleyball and, from 2026 onwards, tennis.

MADCUP promotes values such as respect, effort and teamwork, connecting sport with education, culture, tourism, industry and health.

With a strong presence of international, national and women's teams, MADCUP goes beyond the organisation of sporting events: it invests in audiovisual production and education, and leads the development of an industry that represents 3.3% of Spain's GDP.

Its commitment to the B2B environment is embodied in Sport Summit Madrid, the first major meeting of the sector, consolidating its role as a key player in the global sports ecosystem.

*ABOUT **MADCUP** TENNIS*

MADCUP TENNIS is an international youth team tournament that brings to tennis the model developed by MADCUP in other disciplines over recent years.

The project was created with the aim of establishing a stable and attractive competition aligned with the values of grassroots sport, enabling young tennis players to compete in a mixed team format.

Based in the Community of Madrid, with both national and international ambition, **MADCUP TENNIS** aspires to become a benchmark event within the youth tennis calendar.





PARTICIPATION MODEL

MADCUP TENNIS is a club-based team tournament, with a participation model based on invitation.

In order to guarantee sporting standards, federation alignment and the values of the event, the organisation will prioritise clubs proposed by the Regional Tennis Federations, in coordination with **MADCUP**.

Each Regional Federation may propose one representative club. If the draw is not completed, the organisation reserves the right to directly invite national and international clubs, in accordance with the tournament regulations.

TEAM COMPOSITION

- **4 categories:** U12, U14, U16 and U18
- **Per category:** 2 male players and 1 female player
- **Total:** 12 players per team (with the possibility of reserve players)

Player selection is the exclusive responsibility of each participating club.

COMPETITION FORMAT

CATEGORIES

U12 · U14 · U16 · U18

FORMAT

- Team competition
- Group stage + knockout stage
- Consolation rounds guaranteeing a higher number of matches
- Mixed system promoting equality and team cohesion

SCORING SYSTEM


Each individual match victory earns one point for the team.

EXPECTED PARTICIPATION 2026

24 teams.

SURFACE

Hard court. In the event of adverse weather conditions, matches will be played on indoor courts.



DATES

The choice of dates (25–28 June 2026) is based on sporting, academic and logistical criteria:

- End of the school year
- Favourable weather conditions
- Cost optimisation for families and participating organisations

The tournament is coordinated with the federation calendar and is designed to award points towards the national ranking.


